RE: Village of Ossining Police Proposal to Town of Ossining

This Memorandum will serve to update the Village's Proposal for Providing Police Services to the Unincorporated Portion of the Town dated July 2, 2010.

As discussed in the Village submission to the Town in the paragraph entitled "The Proposal", the Village proposed to integrate a suggested minimum of eleven Town Police Officers, with the footnote to the paragraph suggesting that the Village consider incorporating the entire Town Police Department.

At this time, in the interest of providing an integrated area Police Department, the Village is prepared and does hereby submit its updated proposal to consolidate the entire active Town of Ossining Police Department with the Village's Department (with the exception of the Town Chief of Police, since the Village already has a Chief in place), and to provide service to the Town-outside as previously stated. With this enhancement of the Village's original submission, the Village will match the County's financial proposal including the County's first year estimate of cost of services for 2011 of \$2,173,606., all as more fully set forth in its proposal dated June 9, 2010.
