### **DEPUTY TOWN ATTORNEY**

The Town of Ossining is accepting resumes for the position of Deputy Town Attorney who will work under the supervision of the Town Attorney. The successful applicant must be able to independently handle prosecution of Vehicle and Traffic Law and NYS Department of Transportation summonses and Town Code Violations in the Town of Ossining Justice Court. Additional responsibilities may be assigned by the Town Attorney, on an as needed basis, but primary role will be to act as Town prosecutor. Applicant will be required to be in attendance, when Town Court is in session, as per the established Court schedule, when cases requiring the presence of the Town Prosecutor are scheduled. Minimum commitment of 3 or 4 evenings per month will be expected. Town Prosecutor will handle all plea negotiations or trials of Traffic and Town Code violations. Occasional additional time commitments may be necessary with respect to any non-prosecutor activities assigned by the Town Attorney. Position is considered part time. Salary is \$18,000.00 per year.
