This is your 2008/2009 School Tax Bill.

No reminder notice is sent for the second half payment due in January, 2009. If your property is sold after the September payment date, but prior to the payment of the second half of this school tax bill, you must notify the new owner of the January, 2009, tax payment due.

<u>TO AVOID PENALTIES:</u> If you mail your payment at the end of the month the tax is due, be sure there is a <u>timely official</u> <u>United States postmark</u> on the envelope. Postage meter (i.e. Pitney Bowes) and foreign postmarks are not acceptable. When an envelope containing payment of local taxes contains no U. S. postmark date, payment of such taxes is deemed to have been made on the date the payment is received. (**Real Property Tax Law** §922.)

Please include a telephone number on your check when paying by mail.

To receive a Receipt, please mail back or bring in your <u>entire</u> bill. We will stamp it "PAID" and return it to you.

Please make checks payable to "Town of Ossining."

If you mail or bring a postdated check early in the month, with a <u>written note</u> for us to hold it until the post date, we will deposit it on the last day of the current month.

SCHEDULE OF PENALTIES

Because January 31, 2009, falls on a Saturday, the last day to pay the second half tax without penalties is February 2, 2009.

New York State Law provides that the Tax Receiver <u>cannot</u> waive penalties on real estate taxes after the due date <u>for any reason</u>. (Real Property Tax Law §920.)

A property owner is not relieved of the responsibility for payment of taxes or interest prescribed by law despite the failure to receive a notice of such taxes due. (Real Property Tax Law §922.)
