A series of programs to take place December 5 – 9 throughout Westchester

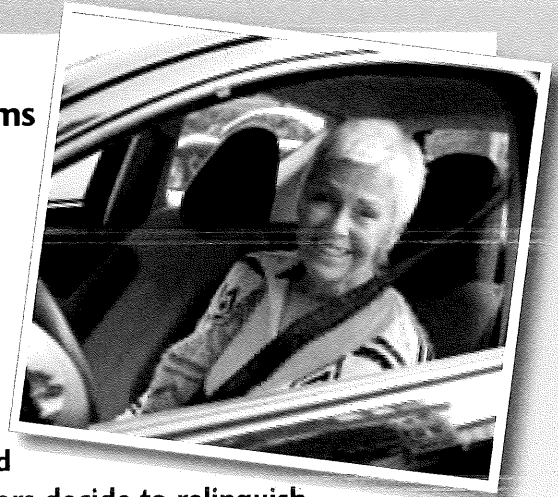
“Keys to Safe Driving” is a series of five free programs
