I. CALL TO ORDER – PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE – ROLL CALL

The Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Ossining was held on February 8, 2011 in the Police/Court Facility, 86-88 Spring Street in Ossining. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Supervisor Catherine Borgia. Members of the Board present were: Councilmembers Geoffrey Harter, Michael Tawil, Peter Tripodi and Northern Wilcher. Also present were Town Attorney Wayne Spector and Town Clerk Mary Ann Roberts.

II. ANNOUNCEMENTS

Councilman Tawil announced that the Board of Education will hold a Hearing at the Roosevelt School on Wednesday, February 9, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. regarding the bonding for facility improvements.

Supervisor Borgia announced that the Town of Ossining Police Department has donated a uniform to the Ossining Historical Society.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA ITEMS

Bobby Williams, Spring Street, questioned Resolution D (Resignations: Police Lieutenant & Police Sergeants) whether there was a reverter clause after the three year contract. In other words, if the Marriage doesn't last, what are the options?

Supervisor Borgia responded that either party can terminate the IMA with one year notice. If we were reconstituting our Police Department, there is no requirement for the Town to re-hire the officers or the former officers to return to the department. Town Attorney Wayne Spector stated that no special position has been created.

Art Sullivan, Town Outside Resident, questioned whether the Town Outside is still left with a part time officer. Supervisor Borgia responded that there is still a Part Time Officer/Court Officer, Chief and an officer out on 207C still on the payroll.
