C. General Electric Re-Zoning

Whereas, an application in the form of a letter from counsel, on behalf of the General Electric Company, seeking to rezone two parcels contiguous with its property, has been received by the town, specifically requesting as follows: as to the parcel designated on the tax map as section 80.15, block 1, Lot 4.1, rezoning from the R-30 district to the BE Business Education district, and, as to the parcel designated on the tax map as section 80.14, block 1, Lot 13, rezoning from the NC Neighborhood Commercial District to the BE Business Education District.

Now Be It Resolved, that the application be referred to the Town of Ossining Planning Board for the purpose of reviewing and rendering its recommendation to the Town Board with respect to the application and that the matter be placed upon the Planning Board agenda as soon as practicable and upon receipt of the analysis and recommendation by the Planning Board, the application will be scheduled for a public hearing before the Town Board pursuant to a subsequent Town Board resolution.
