A. Tax Receiver - Property Redemption, 136 Cedar Lane

Councilmember Jeffrey moved and it was seconded by Councilmember Wilcher that the following be approved:

Whereas, the owner-occupied property located at 136 Cedar Lane, Ossining, has delinquent taxes resulting in commencement of In Rem foreclosure proceedings and a judgment of foreclosure, and

Whereas, the property owners have requested to redeem the property and have tendered full payment; and

Whereas, the Town Board desires to allow the owners of said property a window of opportunity to redeem the property prior to auction;

Now therefore be it Resolved, that the Town Board of the Town of Ossining hereby allows the holder of property at 136 Cedar Lane, Ossining to redeem said property by paying all outstanding taxes, interest, penalties and fees, plus an additional ten (10%) percent penalty on the lien amount, for a total of \$29,758.56, which, upon the recommendation of the Receiver of Taxes, the Town Board finds to be fair and appropriate based on the specific and unique circumstances of this case.
