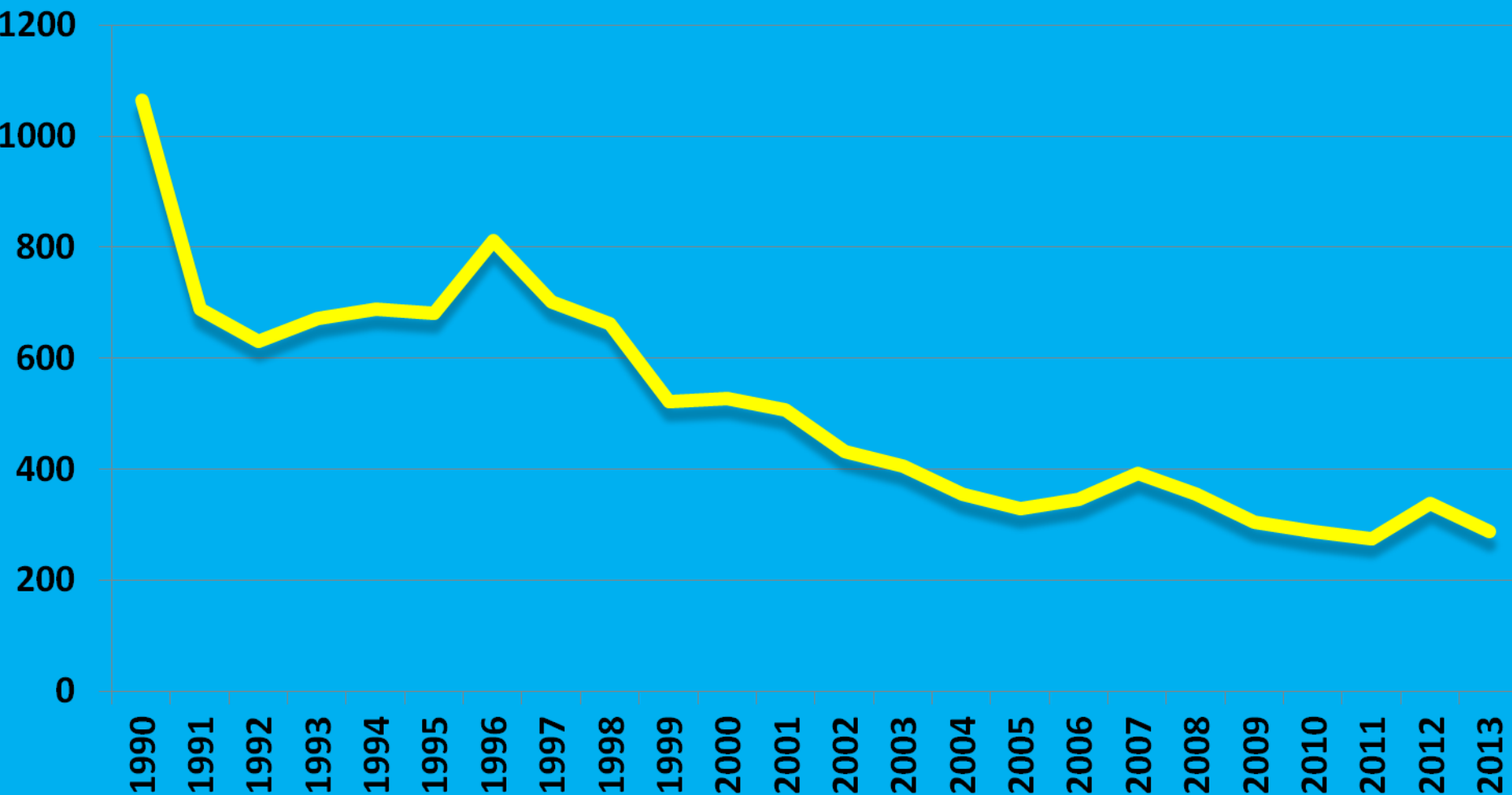

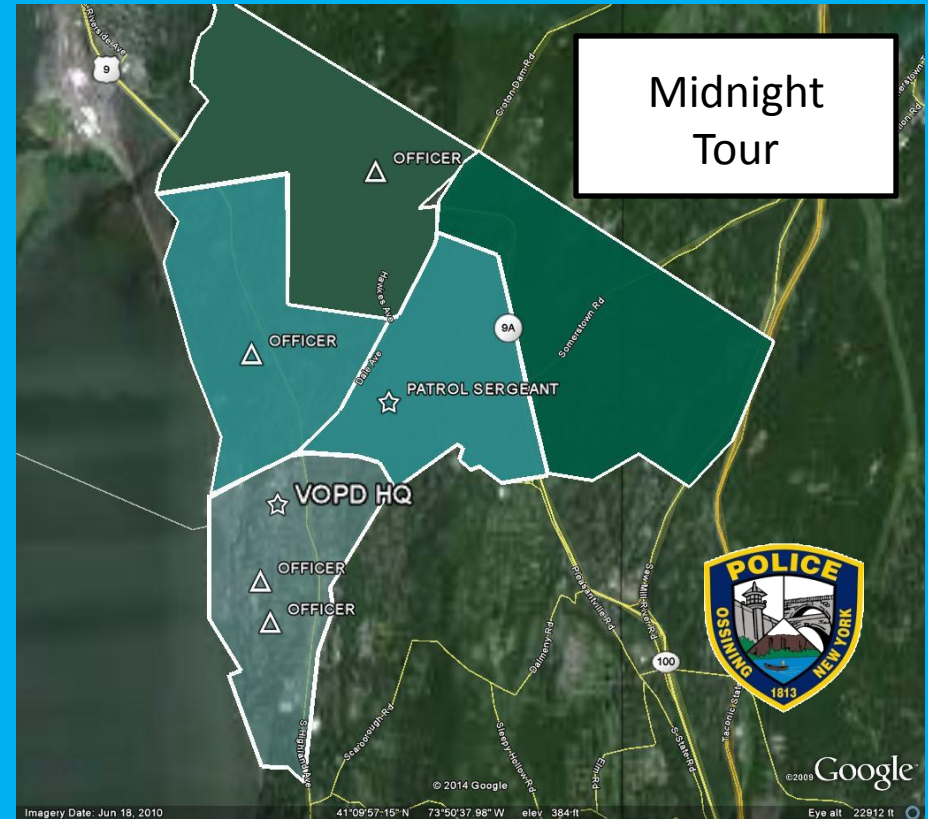
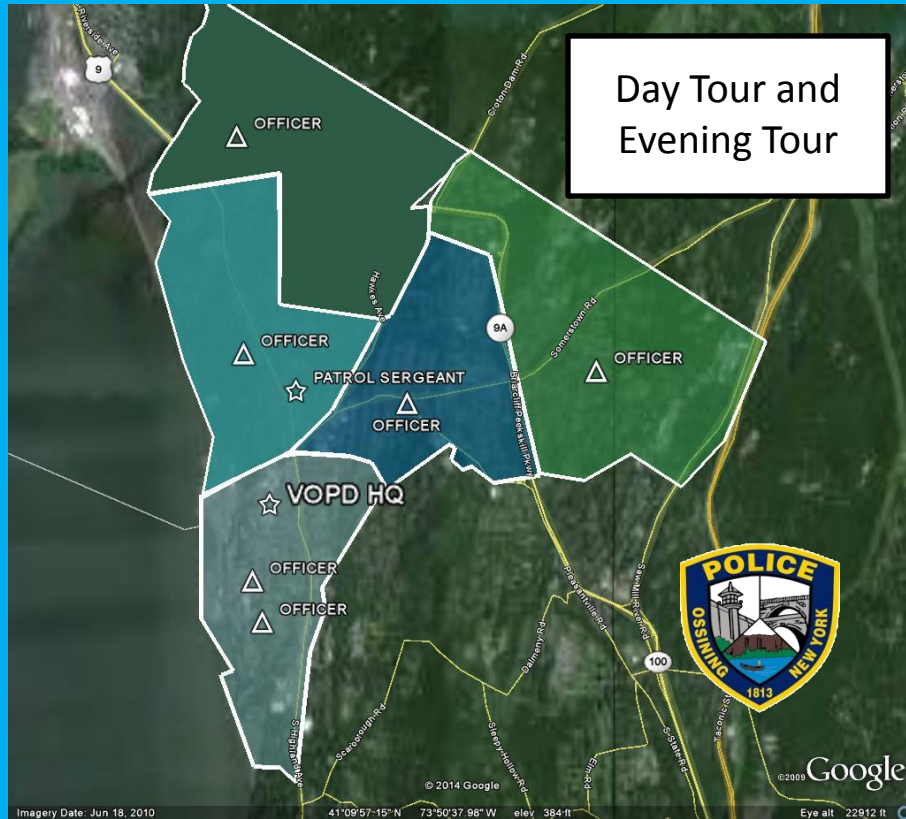

Proposed Sector Maps

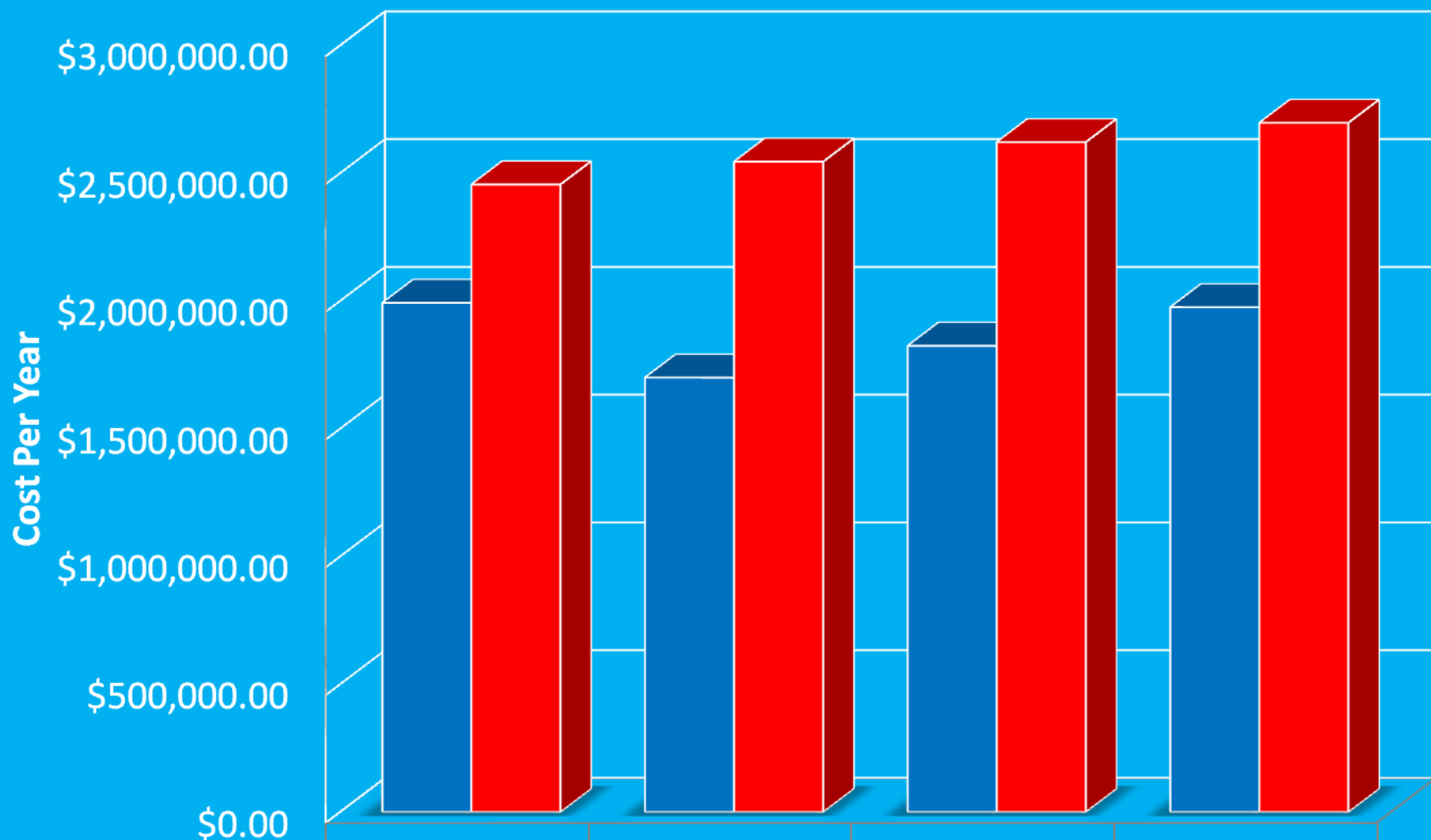

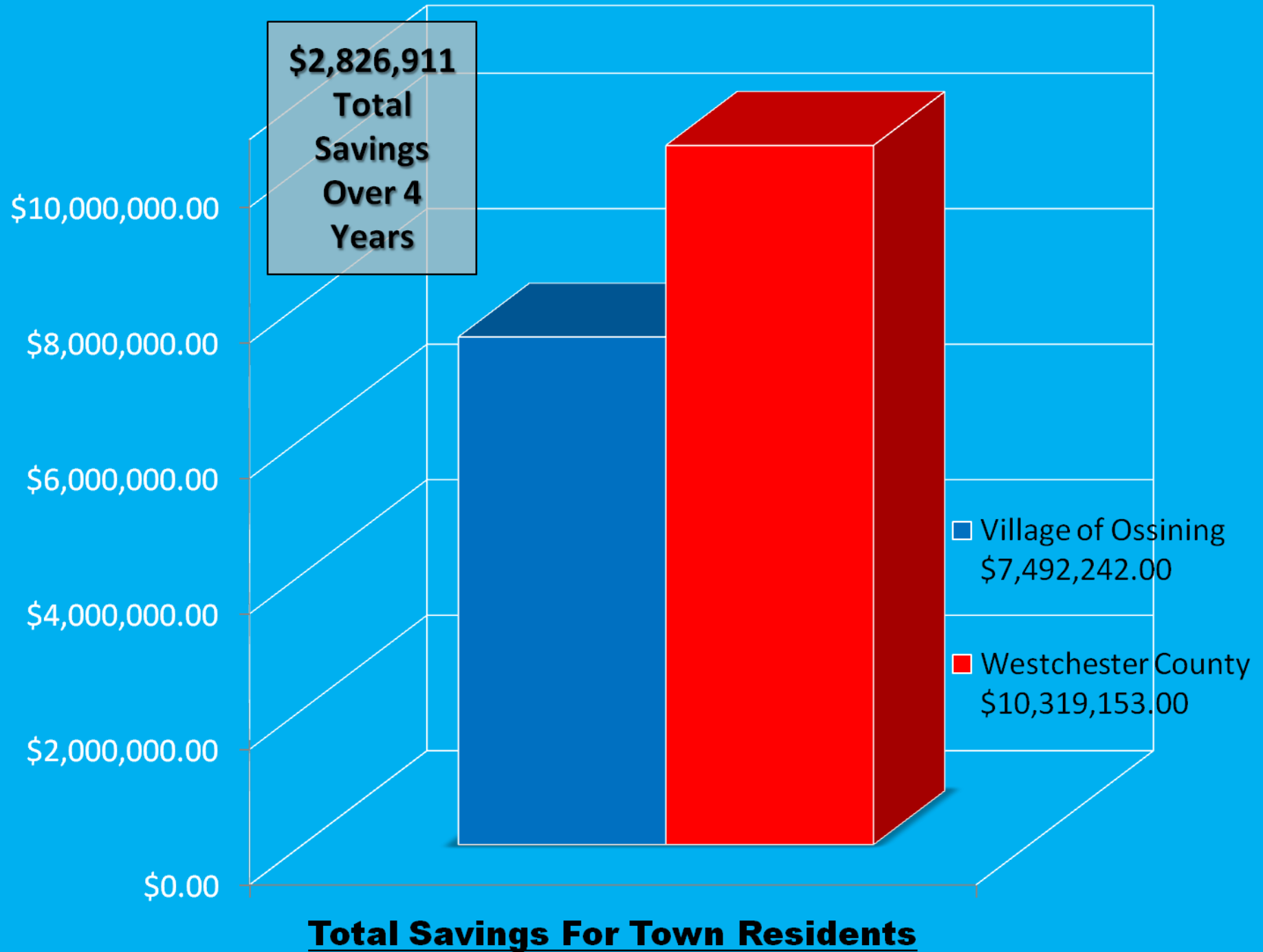
