C. <u>Rally at Louis Engel Park</u>

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2018, the students and families of March For Our Lives will hold a rally in Washington DC to demand that their lives and safety become a priority and that we end gun violence and mass shootings in our schools today; and

WHEREAS, to date, more than 440 related events have been scheduled on March 24 in different locations around the world; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has been made aware that a large number of residents of Ossining and neighboring communities may wish to participate in this event in their local communities; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board fully supports this important message and wants to provide members of the public with a location within the Town to participate in this rally in a safe and orderly manner; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Ossining will, with the Village of Ossining, co-sponsor a local March for Our Lives rally to be held on March 24, 2018 at 12 Noon at Louis Engel Park.
