Property Reassessment Coming to Greenburgh, Ossining, and Yonkers

Fairness, Equity, and Transparency.

These are three words that do not typically come to mind when thinking of property taxes in New York state. The goal of the Multiple Municipal Reassessment Consortium (MMRC) is to change that for its municipalities by way of a reassessment of all real estate. Fairness will come as each property owner will only be asked to pay his share of the property tax burden. When all properties are appraised at fair market value at the same time, and the values meet statistical standards for accuracy, Equity will result. The MMRC is reaching out to all property owners and will provide education and information to enhance the Transparency of the process.
